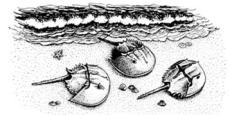


Fall and Winter Nature Programs at Liberty State Park

Low Tide Beach Walk * Saturday, October 14th, 2017 and Saturday, March 10th, 2018 * 10 – 11:30AM

Join us for a stroll along the beach to see what the tide has brought ashore. Please dress to be outdoors and wear old shoes that can get wet and muddy. *You will need your own vehicle to get to the study site.*



Fall Bird Walk * Sunday, October 22nd and Sunday, November 19th, 2017 * 10AM – Noon

Located along the Atlantic Flyway, Liberty State Park is home to over 250 different species of birds. Join us as we explore varied habitats and learn to identify some of our resident and migratory birdlife. *Please dress to be outside and bring binoculars if you have them. Binoculars are available to borrow.*



Fall Leaves Walk * Saturday, November 4th, 2017 * 10AM – 11:30AM

As the weather starts to cool and the leaves begin to change, it's a perfect time to come explore the beauty of fall at Liberty State Park. Join our Park Naturalist on this guided walk and learn how to identify some of our trees by their fall colors.

Winter Evergreen Trees * Saturday, December 2nd, 2017 * 10AM – 11:30AM

Come on out to Liberty State Park and join us for an evergreen investigation. We will learn how to identify different types of evergreens and about the valuable role these trees play in nature.

Winter Waterfowl Walk * Sunday, December 10th, 2017, Sunday, January 21st, & Saturday, February 24th, 2018
