page 17 19 m. [Evaluate] The provisions of section 6 of P.L.1984, c128 (C13: 17-6.1), or any other law, rule, or regulation regarding purchases, contracts, or agreements to the contrary notwithstanding, at the request of the Commissioner of Environmental Protection, **evaluate, approve, and implement any plan or plans for the further preservation, development, enhancement, or improvement of Liberty State Park and the buildings, structures, properties, and appurtenances related thereto, or incidental to, necessary for, or complimentary to the park.** The commission may avail itself of any plans under review by the Department of Environmental Protection from any source that may promote expanded and diverse recreational, cultural, and educational opportunities for visitors to Liberty State Park and provide greater access to park facilities. **Any approved plans shall constitute a project of the commission, and shall be adopted as part of the master plan.** Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to transfer ownership of any of the property of Liberty State Park to the commission or any other person; and
